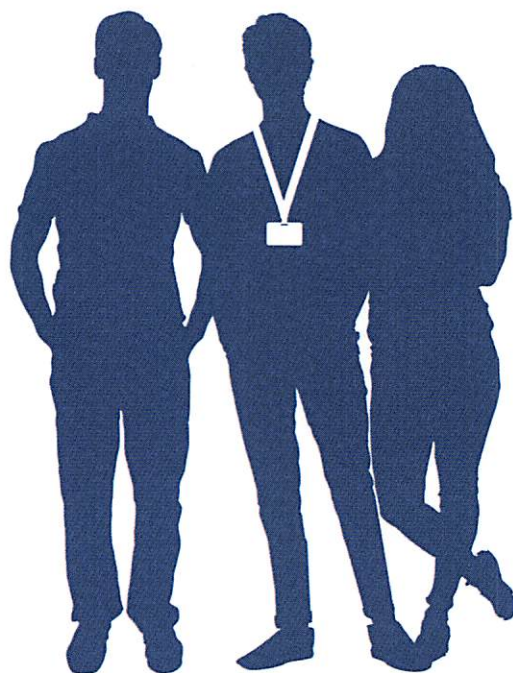


Do you need help with a European Union Settlement Scheme application?

If you (or a family member) are an EU or EEA National living or working in the UK, you need to settle your status before Brexit. Settling your status will allow you access to vital public services.



Our service is free, confidential and impartial. Hounslow Citizens Advice can provide assistance to vulnerable residents living in **HOUNSLOW AND EALING** to make an application through the EU Settlement Scheme via drop-in, telephone or referral.

Our service offers access to free immigration support for vulnerable Hounslow and Ealing residents to apply for settled or pre-settled status in the UK.

Vulnerable residents include:

- **Victims of domestic violence**
- **Victims of modern Slavery and Human Trafficking**
- **EU Families (mistakenly believing that children born in the UK are automatically citizens)**
- **Children & Young People Leaving Care**
- **Older People - Home Visits**
- **Disabled/Seriously Ill People**
- **Residents in Care Homes**
- **Homeless People**

EU, EEA and Swiss Citizens living and working in the UK after Brexit should register with the EU Settlement Scheme to be able to:

- **work in the UK**
- **use the NHS**
- **enrol in education or continue studying**
- **access public funds (eg. benefits and pensions) if eligible**
- **travel in and out of the UK**
- **stay in the UK as long as you like if you get settled status. You'll also be able to apply for British citizenship if you're eligible.**
