During the hours detailed below, residents of the London Borough of Hounslow can attend any one of the **drop-in** sessions without an appointment on a **first come, first served** basis. The number of clients we see depends on the volunteers available on the day. At the drop-in session you will have a short discussion with an assessor who will identify the most appropriate way for us to help you. This could be giving you the information you need to solve your problem yourself or it could be making an appointment to discuss your problem further. Sometimes we might direct you to a specialist or an external organisation that is better placed to help with your query.

Specialist Advice Team: Providing specialist Debt Management and Welfare Benefit advice & advocacy.

Thames Water Project for Debt Advice and Digital Coaching: Debt advice and assistance with Thames Water issues. Also, we provide digital support for Hounslow residents, including help using online information.
