



General Advice Services

During the hours detailed below, residents of the London Borough of Hounslow can attend any one of the drop-in sessions without an appointment on a first come, first serve basis. It is advisable to be early as there may be a queue. The number of tickets given out is dependent on how many advisers are available. At the drop-in session you will have a short discussion with an assessor who will identify the most appropriate way for us to help you. This could be giving you the information you need to solve your problem yourself or it could be making an appointment to discuss your problem further. Sometimes we might direct you to a specialist that is better placed to help.
